Veterans/Veterans Advocates – New Requirement

Legislative Change to CA <u>WIC 5604 Membership</u> for CA's 59 Local Mental/Behavioral Health Boards/Commissions

Veteran Requirement: One member shall be a <u>veteran</u> or <u>veteran advocate</u>. (For counties with a <u>population of 100,000 or more</u>)

Veteran Encouragement: A county shall give a strong preference to appointing at least one member of the board who is a veteran or a veteran advocate. (For counties with a <u>population fewer than 100,000</u>)

Vacancy Notification: A county shall <u>notify its county veterans service officer about vacancies</u> on the board, if a county has a veterans service officer.

"Veteran Advocate" Defined: A parent, spouse, or adult child of a veteran, or an individual who is part of a veterans organization, including the Veterans of Foreign Wars or the American Legion.
