CA Association of Local Behavioral Health Boards & Commissions (CALBHB/C) Governing Board Meeting (Zoom Conference Call) June 19, 2020 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 11:30 am by President Harriette Stevens, Ed.D.

Minutes: Jerry Harris made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 29, 2020 meeting. Kristine Haataja seconded the motion. Supervisor Corless abstained. The motion carried.

Finances: Comstock presented the "Statement of Financial Position" and "Statement of Activity,". Total Equity as of June 11, 2020 was \$140,460.73. A motion to accept the financial reports as presented was made by Vice President Benavidez with a second by Lynda Kaufmann. The motion carried unanimously.

The minutes and financials were sent electronically to Governing Board members prior to the meeting.

Budget: Comstock presented a 2020-21 Budget (Draft) for the Governing Board's consideration. She noted:

- 1. Proposed projected revenue takes into consideration the likely impact of COVID-19 on state and local budgets.
- 2. Although compensation is comparatively low, payroll expenses were kept at prior levels due to concerns about revenue over the next few years.

Jerry Harris made a motion to approve the 2020-21 Budget as presented. Bill Stewart seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Election of Officers: The slate of nominees for fiscal year 2020-21 officer positions included: President: Harriette S. Stevens, Ed.D. Vice President: Benny Benavidez Secretary/Treasurer: Mae Sherman

Lynda Kaufmann made a motion to approve the slate. Jerry Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

AB 2377: Adult Residential Facilities (Board & Cares) (Closures) - Stacy Dalgleish made a motion to support <u>AB 2377</u>. Bill Stewart seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Federal Appropriations and Bills - Comstock provided brief summaries of the following (<u>link to</u> <u>summaries</u>), followed by discussion.

- 1. Emergency Appropriation of \$38.5 Billion for Mental Health and Addiction Treatment
- 2. Crisis Stabilization and Community Reentry Act of 2020 (S. 3312)
- 3. National Suicide Hotline Designation Act of 2020 (H.R. 4194)

Jerry Harris made a motion to support the above three items. Patrick Ogawa seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Comstock will communicate CALBHB/C leadership's support of these items in conjunction with the National Council for Behavioral Health's "Hill Day at Home", June 24, 2020.

 - a. Funding the <u>CA BH Safety Net</u>: The revised state budget includes \$750 million to address the projected public safety realignment funding shortfall.
 - b. <u>SB 855</u> Health coverage: mental health or substance abuse disorders : This bill is moving through committees. CALBHB/C has provided opportunities for action for MH/BH boards/commission members in specific districts around California.
 - c. <u>SB 803</u> continues to move through committees.
