Minutes: Jerry Harris made a motion to approve the November 20th Minutes; Bill Stewart seconded the motion. Jessica Bennett abstained. The motion passed.

Financials:

- A. Announcement of new Secretary/Treasurer Kristine Haataja (appointed by President Stevens)
- B. Reports: "Budget vs. Actuals" and "Statement of Financial Position" and "A/R Aging Detail" reports (all dated December 11, 2020) were discussed. Total Assets reported: \$155,389.29.
 Benny Benavidez made a motion to approve the Financial Reports as presented; Bill Stewart seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- C. Budget Adjustment: Jerry Harris made a motion to update the 2020-21 budget to include \$4000 for two internship positions (intern positions estimated to be 5-7 hours per week for 10-16 weeks, \$15/hour). Shera Banbury seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Annual Goals:

A 2021 Annual Goals document was discussed. Benny Benavidez motioned to approve the <u>2021 Annual Goals</u> as presented. Jerry Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Related to Annual Goal #2 "Crisis Care Continuum", San Diego has new projects to address reducing 5150's and use of emergency rooms, with hubs, providing treatment and short-term housing. (Stewart)

Legislation:

SB-14, School-Based Mental Health was discussed. This bill may be considered for support at a later date when more information is known.

Executive Director's Report: Comstock reported on:

- B. Lanterman Petris Short (LPS) Act
 - 1. Comstock was invited to attend the Steinberg's Institute's LPS Act Convening
 - 2. Comstock is working to provide an "Issue Brief" regarding the LPS Act. Related to this, Harris planned to forward the NAMI LPS Town Hall Materials to Comstock
- C. Status of MHSOAC Contract: The contract is being reviewed by MHSOAC attorneys.
