 Allows local and state legislative bodies to hold meetings via conference calls while still meeting state transparency requirements.

Public Meetings by Teleconference: POSTING

- **Timing:** Post 72 Hours in Advance (At Least)
- Include:
 - Agenda
 - Connection Information (Links, Phone Numbers)
 - Notification that it will be recorded (Legal reasons)
 - Packet Materials (if available)
- Email and/or Mail to board/commission members, staff, speakers (and others as able)
- Local Media: Encourage Posting in "Community Events" in local paper

 - Notify people if the meeting will be recorded.

Zoom Teleconferences: SETTING UP

- "Schedule a Meeting"
- Set Up
 - Name of meeting
 - Password
 - Video (on or off for host and/or participant)
 - Audio (Telephone and Computer Audio)
 - Meeting
 - Mute participants upon entry
 - Enable Waiting Room
 - Record meeting automatically in the cloud (if desired)

Zoom Teleconferences: HOSTING

- Join with computer OR phone audio
- Manage Participants allows host to:
 - "Mute" or "Unmute"
 - See Raised Hands
- Share (allows host and participants to share full screen or applications (such as PowerPoint)
- End Meeting
